36th & 51st VA Infantry Engagements with a Chronology of the Civil War and Other Resources

This cd-rom contains timelines of the engagements of the 36th and 51st Virginia Infantry regiments, side-by-side with a chronology of the Civil War, 1860-1865. The timelines also highlight basic information about the service of the three Groseclose brothers who served in the two regiments: Lt. James A.T. Groseclose (51st VA Inf, Co F), Capt. Henry C. Groseclose (36th VA Inf, Co G), and Pvt. Adam D. Groseclose (51st VA Inf, Co F). The three brothers were captured at the Battle of Opequon (3rd Winchester) in September 1864, and all three brothers survived the War after imprisonment at Fort Delaware and Point Lookout.

Among the other resources included on the cd-rom are images of the three Groseclose brothers, their complete muster rolls and other service records compiled by the US National Archives, a list of all Groseclose enlistees in Virginia military service during the Civil War, and short biographies and memoirs of generals and some junior officers who led the 51st VA Infantry Regiment during the course of the War.
